#### 1. REPORTING ENTITY

These financial statements are prepared for Barclays Directors Limited (the "Company"), which is dormant. The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Barclays Bank PLC and its ultimate parent company is Barclays PLC, both of which prepare consolidated financial statements in accordance with IFRS, and accordingly consolidated financial statements have not been prepared.

The Company is a private limited company, incorporated in the United Kingdom and registered in England and Wales.

#### 2. COMPLIANCE WITH INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS"), adopted for use in the European Union. In all respects this is also in accordance with IFRS, including the interpretations issues by the International Financial Reporting Interpretations Committee.

#### 3. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied, except for the first time application of IFRS.

#### **Basis of preparation**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. They are stated in pounds, sterling, the currency of the country in which the Company is incorporated.

#### First time application of IFRS

The Company has applied IFRS in its financial reporting with effect from 1 January 2005, in accordance with the transitional provisions set out in IFRS 1, "First-time Adoption of International Financial Reporting Standards". Previously, the Company followed UK pronouncements of its Urgent Issues Task Force and the Companies Act 1985, (collectively UK GAAP). The application of IFRS has had no effect on the carrying amounts of the Company's assets, liabilities or equity as reported under UK GAAP.

#### **Income Statement**

An income statement has not been prepared as there are no transactions required to be reflected in for either 2005 or 2004. The Company has made neither profit nor loss, nor any other recognised income or expense.
