  existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (3) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"
- (4) the Claimants the Company and Shelly Lynn Byers and Sanmina-SCI Systems Holdings Inc do jointly and severally pay to the

## Registrar of Companies his costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £300-00

(5) the hearing fixed for the 12th June 2009 be vacated
