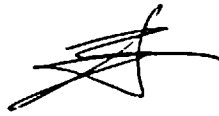

1. Introduction

The Company affairs are now concluded and this is the Joint Liquidators' report and account of the Liquidation showing how it has been conducted, both in the UK and in Luxembourg and how the Company property has been disposed.

The purpose of this report is to detail the Joint Liquidators' acts and dealings, together with the conduct of the Joint Liquidators during the Liquidation, since the Appointment Date.

2. Progress of the Liquidation

The manner in which the affairs and business of the Company have been managed since the opening of the Liquidation and the appointment of Joint Liquidators are set out below.

Asset Realisations

Cash at Bank

The DoS of the Company reports cash at bank of £4,000.

On the Appointment Date, the Joint Liquidators distributed the cash balances to the Member in accordance with a Distribution and Assumption Agreement dated 2 January 2020. Please see Section 4 for further details.

Investments

The DoS of the Company reports investments of £74,423,000. The investments relate to a promissory note issued by Signature Aviation US Holdings Inc ("SAUSH") in favour of the Company in the principal amount of £74,423,000.

The promissory note was issued by SAUSH as consideration for the sale of preferred shares held by the Company back to SAUSH.

On the Appointment Date, the Joint Liquidators distributed in specie the investments to the Member in accordance with a Distribution and Assumption Agreement. Please see Section 4 for further details.

Other Matters

The Joint Liquidators have obtained VAT, PAYE and Corporation Tax clearance from HMRC to close the Liquidation in the Reporting Period.

The Joint Liquidators have also ensured that all relevant tax returns have been filed in Luxembourg. In accordance, with the Distribution and Assumption Agreement, any Luxembourg tax liabilities falling due have been settled by the Member. There are no outstanding liabilities in this regard.

There will be no further asset realisations.

3. Liabilities and Dividends

Creditors

The DoS reports that the Company had creditor balances totalling £827,000.

In accordance with the Distribution and Assumption Agreement, the Member agreed to assume the liabilities of the Company.

Furthermore, the Joint Liquidators advertised the Liquidation in the London Gazette and requested that any creditors prove their debts. No creditor claims have been received.

4. Distributions to the Member

During the Liquidation a single distribution was declared, on the Appointment Date, for a total balance of £74,427,000. The distribution included the promissory note from SAUSH in favour of the Company in the principal amount of £74,423,000 and cash balances of £4,000. This represented a total distribution of £21.5730 per £1 ordinary share, based on a total of 3,450,000 £1 ordinary shares.

The distribution was effected in accordance with the Distribution and Assumption Agreement entered into with the Member. The Member agreed to accept the transfer of all of the Company's rights, title and interest in the assets and to assume all of the Company's duties and obligations from the Appointment Date.

There will be no further distributions to the Member.

5. **Joint Liquidators'** Costs and Expenses

A written resolution was passed on 2 January 2020 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed at their charging rates accordingly to the time properly spent by them and members of their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up of the Companies.

In the event, the Joint Liquidators remuneration has been paid by another group company and accordingly no detailed analysis is included in this report.

6. Joint Liquidators Receipts and Payments Account

A detailed receipts and payments account for the Reporting Period is shown in Appendix 1.

7. Conclusion

In the UK, the Joint Liquidators have completed their administration of the Liquidation. Their vacation of office and release from liability will follow.

In Luxembourg, in accordance with local legislation, the Member has resolved to close the Luxembourg liquidation of the Company and passed the following resolutions:

- the approval of this report and account and the liquidation interim financial statements of the Company;
- the waiver of the appointment of a Luxembourg liquidation auditor;
- the discharge to the Joint Liquidators for the performance of their mandate in Luxembourg;
- determined the place where the books and documents of the Company will be kept for a period of 5 (five) years as from the closing of its liquidation; and
- approved the closing of the liquidation of the Company;
