"Credit Agreement" means the £1,250,000,000 revolving credit facility agreement between Imperial Tobacco Group PLC (1), Midland Bank plc and NatWest Capital Markets Limited as arrangers (2), the Banks named therein (3) and Lloyds Bank Plc as agent (4) and to which ITF and ITH acceded on 1 October 1996.

Auditors' report to the directors of Imperial Tobacco Limited pursuant to section 156(4) of the Companies Act 1985
