#### LIQUIDATORS' REPORT

At the outset of the liquidation, on the basis of the information stated on the declaration of solvency, there was an intercompany debtor amount owed to the Company of £257,070.00 and there were no liabilities. During the liquidation it came to light that a repayment of £12.51 was due to the Company from HM Revenue & Customs.

The matters completed during the course of the liquidation have included mandatory liquidation tasks such as statutory advertising, filings and notifications of the liquidation, plus obtaining formal clearances/searches from HM Land Registry and The Pension Tracing Service I have also liaised with HM Revenue & Customs in order to settle tax issues including corporation tax clearance.

The repayment from HM Revenue & Customs of £12 51 and the intercompany debtor amount of £257,070.00 were distributed in specie to the sole shareholder prior to the closure of the liquidation. This represents a capital distribution of approximately 101.6 pence per share in respect of 253,000 Ordinary £1 shares issued by the Company

The liquidators' fees and expenses have been settled by the group parent company, Cameron Limited. The basis of the remuneration was fixed by reference to the time properly spent by the liquidators and their staff in attending to matters arising in the winding up. The basis was fixed by resolution of the shareholders.

No assets have proved to be unrealisable
