Directors' report

The Directors present the Annual Report and Financial Statements of Mitie Security (London) Limited ('the Company') for the year ended 31 March 2019.

Business review

The Company did not trade during the year and the Directors expect this to continue for the foreseeable future.

In the year the Company waived £7,531,000 (2018: £nil) of amounts owed by Group undertakings. Also during the year, the Company reduced issued share capital by £221,000 (2018: £nil) and cancelled £188,000 (2018: £nil) of share premium.

As shown in the company's profit and loss account on page 5, the Company's turnover was £nil (2018:£nil) and the loss after tax was £7,531,000 (2018:£nil).

Going concern

The Directors, having assessed the responses of the Directors of the Company's ultimate parent Mitie Group plc to their enquiries have no reason to believe that a material uncertainty exists that may cast significant doubt about the ability of the Mitie Group to continue as a going concern or its ability to continue with the current banking arrangements.

On the basis of their assessment of the Company's financial position and of the enquiries made of the Directors of Mitie Group plc, the Company's Directors have a reasonable expectation that the Company will be able to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. Thus they continue to adopt the going concern basis of accounting in preparing the annual financial statements.



Notes

1 Accounting policies, judgements and estimates

a) General information

Mitie Security (London) Limited (the "Company") is a private company limited by shares and is incorporated in England and Wales and domiciled in the UK. The Company's registered number is 02010534. The Company's registered office is Level 12, The Shard, 32 London Bridge Street, SE1 9SG. Details of the Company's activities are set out in the Directors' Report.

b) Statement of compliance with FRS101

These financial statements were prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 101 *Reduced Disclosure Framework* ("FRS 101").

In preparing these financial statements, the Company applies the recognition, measurement and disclosure requirements of International Financial Reporting Standards as adopted by the EU ("Adopted IFRSs"), but makes amendments where necessary in order to comply with Companies Act 2006 and has set out below where advantage of the FRS 101 disclosure exemptions has been taken.

c) Basis of preparation

In these financial statements, the Company has applied the exemptions available under FRS 101 in respect of the following disclosures:

- a Cash Flow Statement and related notes;
- Comparative period reconciliations for share capital;
- Disclosures in respect of capital management;
- The effects of new but not yet effective IFRSs;
- Disclosures in respect of the compensation of Key Management Personnel;
- Disclosure in respect of related party transactions entered into between two or more members of a group, provided that any subsidiary which is a party to the transaction is wholly owned by such a member.

As the consolidated financial statements of Mitie Group plc include the equivalent disclosures, the Company has also taken the exemptions under FRS 101 available in respect of the following disclosures:

- Certain disclosures required by IFRS 13 *Fair Value Measurement* and the disclosures required by IFRS 7 *Financial Instrument Disclosures*.

There are no new and mandatorily effective standards in the year that would have a material impact on the financial statements.

Accounting policies have, unless otherwise stated, been applied consistently to all periods presented in these financial statements.
