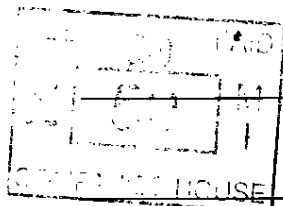

| Prescribed particulars<br>① | <p>The Company has a single class of share capital, which is divided into ordinary shares of 25p each. Each ordinary share has one vote on a poll. Each member attending a general meeting in person has one vote on a show of hands. In the case of joint holders of a share the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of votes of the other joint shareholders. Seniority will be determined by the order in which the joint holders' names are listed in the register. Under the Companies Act 2006, members are entitled to appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of their rights to attend and speak and vote on their behalf at a general meeting. A member may appoint more than one proxy in relation to a general meeting provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise the rights attached to a different share or shares held by that member. Proxies may vote in a poll or on a show of hands. A member that is a corporation may appoint one or more individuals to act on its behalf at a general meeting as a corporate representative. Where more than one corporate representative has been appointed, any one of them is entitled to vote and exercise other powers on behalf of the member at a general meeting or class meeting. There are currently no restrictions imposed by the Company on the voting rights of any member of the Company.</p> |
