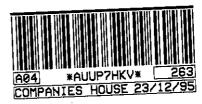

3. Accounts

The Company is considered to have commenced to operate from the 7 October 1986 to adminster management of the property of 67 Cadogan Square Company Limited.

4. Result

A surplus in the year of £783 was recorded, which gives a balance on the Revenue Account to carry forward of £5,920.

5. Officers

The Council is as shown above.

6. Responsibilities

Company law requires the Council to prepare accounts for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the company and of the surplus or deficit of the company for that period. In preparing those accounts, the Council are required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue in business.

The Council are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and to enable them to ensure that the accounts comply with the Companies Act 1985. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

6. Auditors

Messrs Hughes & Co. expressed their willingness to continue as Auditors and a resolution for their appointment will be made at the Annual General Meeting.

Report of the Auditors to the Members of 67 Cadogan Square Company Limited

We have audited the financial statements on pages 2 and 3 which have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Respective responsibilities of the council and auditors

Basis of opinion
