REVIEW OF THE BUSINESS

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with applicable accounting and financial reporting standards, all of which have been applied consistently throughout this year and the preceding year.

2. CALLED-UP SHARE CAPITAL

The authorised, issued and fully paid share capital at June 30, 1999 and June 30, 1998 was 100 ordinary shares of £1 each.
