 - 1.2 The full-stop at the end of paragraph 4(D) is replaced with a semi-colon and paragraph 4 is further amended by the addition of a new sub-paragraph as follows:
 - to or for the benefit of CSV for its charitable objects, whether by way of grant or otherwise.".
 - 1.3 A new paragraph 5 is inserted after paragraph 4, with subsequent paragraphs and any related cross references being amended as required:
 - 14 "5. Conflicts of Interest
 - 5.1 A member of the Council has a duty under the Companies Act 2006 to avoid a situation or matter (including a transaction or arrangement with the Association) in which he / she has, or can have, a conflict of interest. This duty applies to the exploitation of any property, information or opportunity (and it is immaterial whether the Association could take advantage of the property, information or opportunity).
 - 52 Pursuant to section 181(3) of the Companies Act 2006, the duty referred to in Article 5.1 does not apply to a conflict of interest arising in relation to any situation or matter or any transaction or arrangement between the Association and.
