Organisational structure:

The charity has a management committee of up to 6 members who meet at regular intervals and are responsible for the strategic direction and policy of the charity.

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the major risks.

Objectives and principal activities

The charity's objectives are the provision of pastoral and spiritual accompaniment and counselling for the benefit primarily for the clergy and religious and church people. This continued to be the primary activity during the year under review.

Financial review:

for the year ended 31 December 2019

It is the policy of the charity that unrestricted funds which have not been designated for a specific purpose should be maintained at a level equivalent to between three and six month's expenditure. The trustees consider that reserves at this level will ensure that, in the event of a significant drop in funding, they will be able to continue the charity's current activities while consideration is given to ways in which additional funds may be raised. The level of reserves has been maintained throughout the year under review.
