ORDER

UPON the Petition of Parkdale Group Limited ("the Company") by its Joint Administrators presented to the Court on 28th June 2000

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Petitioner

AND UPON reading the documents recorded on the Court File as having been read

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

- 1 The Administration Order in relation to the Company be discharged.
- 2 The Company be wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 3 Edward Victor Lawrence Blackwell and David Harry Gilbert, the Joint Administrators, be appointed Joint Liquidators of the Company for the purpose of winding it up.

- 4 The Joint Administrators be released as administrators pursuant to section 20 of the Insolvency Act 1986 14 days after filing their final receipts and payments account.
- 5 Any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by the liquidator may be done by both or either one of the persons for the time being holding that office.
- 6 The costs of and incidental to this application be paid as an expense of the Administration.
