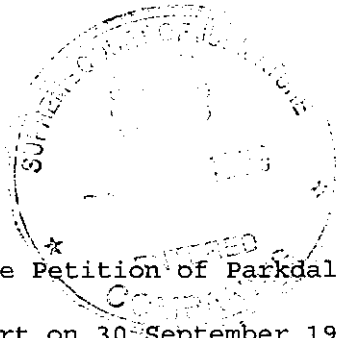

ORDER

UPON the Petition of Parkdale Group Limited ("the Company") presented to
the Court on 30 September 1999

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Petitioners

AND UPON reading the evidence

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

1 The time for hearing of the Petition be abridged to 30 September
1999.

2 Service of the Petition on:-

2.1 Edward Victor Lawrence Blackwell ("Mr Blackwell") and David
or BDO SAY HAYWARD, BOWMAN HOUSE, 2110 BRIDGE STREET READING
Harry Gilbert ("Mr Gilbert") being the proposed Administrators; BOKS
and RG12 LU

2.2 Johnson Fry Holdings plc of 20 Regent Street, London, SW1Y 4PZ

and the Bank of Scotland of Beauclerc House, 3 Queen's Road,
Reading, Berkshire, RG1 4AR, being the persons entitled to
appoint an Administrative Receiver in relation to the Company,

be dispensed with.

3 During the period for which this Order is in force, the affairs,
business and property of the Company be managed by the Administrators
hereinafter appointed pursuant to the provisions of section 8 of the
Insolvency Act 1986 for the following purpose: namely a more
advantageous realisation of the Company's assets than would be
effected on a Winding Up.

4 Mr Blackwell and Mr Gilbert, of BDO Stoy Hayward, be appointed
Administrators of the Company.

5 The costs of the Petition, the costs of and incidental to the
preparation of the independent report prepared by Mr Blackwell
(including the legal costs thereof) be paid as an expense of the
administration.

AND IT IS DECLARED that during the period for which the Order is in force
any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by the
Administrator may be done by both or either one of the persons for the time
being holding that office.
