REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS

Principal activities and review of the year

The principal activity of Cater Allen Lloyd's Holdings Limited (the "Company") was to act as a holding company to Cater Allen Syndicate Management Limited. The Company disposed of its interest in Cater Allen Syndicate Management Limited during May 2018.

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The Company did not carry out any business during the current financial year. It received no income and incurred no expenditure and consequently has made neither a profit nor a loss. The Company is expected to remain dormant during 2022.

Results and dividends

The Company has made neither profit nor loss, nor any other recognised gain or loss in the year. An income statement, statement of comprehensive income and statement of changes in equity has been prepared to reflect the prior year results. The directors do not recommend the payment of a final dividend (2020: £nil).

Post Balance Sheet Events

No adjusting or significant non-adjusting events have occurred between the 31 December 2021 and the date of authorisation of the financial statements.

Impact of Covid-19

In 2021, there were ongoing challenges in terms of navigating the changing circumstances presented by the Covid-19 pandemic, including its impact on the economy and upon home and office working arrangements. The Company continues to monitor the impact of Covid-19; and intends to take a coordinated approach with the other members of the Santander UK plc group where applicable. There has been no significant change to the carrying value of its assets and liabilities at the reporting date.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented, unless otherwise stated.

General information

The Company is a private company limited by shares, domiciled and incorporated in the United Kingdom and is part of a European listed group whose ultimate parent is Banco Santander SA. The registered office address of the Company is 2 Triton Square, Regent's Place, London NW1 3AN. The nature of the Company's operations and its principal activities are set out in the Report of the Directors.

Basis of preparation

These financial statements are prepared for Cater Allen Lloyd's Holdings Limited under the Companies Act 2006.

The Company's financial statements have been prepared in accordance with UK-adopted international accounting standards (IAS). On 31 December 2020, International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs) as adopted by the European Union at that date were brought into UK law and became UKadopted IAS, with future changes being subject to endorsement by the UK Endorsement Board. The Company transitioned to UK-adopted IAS in its financial statements on 1 January 2021, however, this change had no impact on recognition, measurement or disclosures in the periods reported.

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The functional and presentation currency of the Company is sterling.
