We act for International Alert with charity number 327553 (the 'Charity').

Thank you for providing consent to the Charity's application to change their objects (CRM:0049597).

We write further to your email in relation to the Charity's application to change the trustee benefit clause (please see attached for reference) and we note that the Commission has provided their consent on the basis that clauses 4.4.4 and 4.5.4 are amended. The Charity accepts the amendments in principle, however we would like to ensure that the definitions contained in the clauses are consistent the rest of the articles to avoid any confusion.

Please therefore find our amendments to the Commission's suggested clause 4.4.4 and 4.5.4 in red below:

- 4.4.4 (d) a Trustee or connected person a person who is Connected with a Trustee may receive interest on money lent to the charity Association at a reasonable and proper rate which must be not more than the Bank of England bank rate (also known as the base rate);
- 4.5.4 a Trustee or a person who is Connected with a Trustee may, with the approval of the Trustees, receive interest on money lent to any sSubsidiary charity Company, which must not be more than the Bank of England bank rate (also known as the base rate).;

Given that the Commission has accepted the defined terms in Charity's articles, we assume you will find these changes acceptable, and we look forward to hearing from the Commission on this matter.
