

**GREATER MANCHESTER LOW PAY UNIT****SPECIAL RESOLUTION**

In order for this special resolution to take effect there is a requirement that it should be passed by not less than three quarters of members present in person and entitled to vote.

It is being proposed to reduce the numbers required for a quorum of the Management Committee from seven to five, to help the Unit to undertake its work effectively by ensuring that Management Committee meetings are quorate while maintaining sufficient numbers and expertise on the Management Committee to allow proper debate, discussion and decision making on the work of the Unit and on policy and other matters.

**Articles of Association****Article 54**

The quorum necessary for the transaction of the business of the Management Committee shall be (seven) five Management Committee members.
