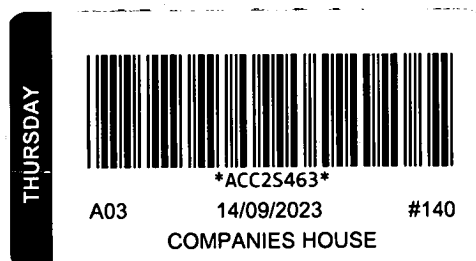

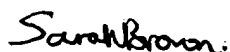

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Hereford Cathedral Enterprises Limited is a private company, limited by shares and registered in England and Wales. The Company's registered number and registered office address can be found in the Company Information on page 1.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provision of Section 1A "Small Entities of Financial Reporting Standard 102" the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland and Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historic cost convention.

Turnover

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents sales made during the year.

Tangible fixed assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost and where this exceeds £2,000, are capitalised.

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of a tangible fixed asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows

Fixtures and Equipment - 4 years

Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Pension costs - defined contribution scheme

Contributions are charged to the profit and loss account as they become payable in accordance with the rules of the scheme.

Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as either financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities.

Government Grants

Due to the Coronavirus situation arising in March 2020, the company has benefitted from National and Local Government grants. These grants have been reported as income and not netted off against any costs to which they relate.

8. RELATED PARTY DISCLOSURES

The company was under the control of the Chapter of Hereford Cathedral throughout the current and previous year.

During the year no charitable donation was made to the Chapter of Hereford Cathedral (2021: £0).

The Chapter of Hereford Cathedral provided management and office services of nil value during the year (2021: £0). Hereford Cathedral Enterprises Ltd provided marketing, events, and tour services of £55,735 to the Chapter of Hereford Cathedral (2021: nil). Goods and provisions to the value of £15,894 (2021: £13,273) were purchased from the Chapter of Hereford Cathedral and goods and provisions to the value of £4,288 (2021: £1,099) were recharged to the Chapter of Hereford Cathedral during the year. At the end of the year £25,213 was due to The Chapter of Hereford Cathedral (2021: £91,463).
