At the 18th Annual General Meeting of The National Childbirth Trust ('NCT') held on Saturday, 1 July 2006 at 10.15 a.m. at The Brighton Centre, Kings Road, BRIGHTON **BN1 2GR.** The following special resolution was proposed and passed

## **Special Resolution 1**

NB: The main thrust of the Special resolution is to enable the NCT wherever possible and appropriate to communicate with its members by email and using the Internet.

## That Article 20 of the Articles of Association be amended so that it reads:

- "20.1 All notices (including but not limited to notices under article 18.4 and notices of general meetings) will be sent to the member's registered email address (and in the case of a joint email address only one notice need be sent to that address which constitutes notice to all members at the same postal address as the member receiving the email)
- 20.2 In the absence of a registered email address for a member in accordance with article 20.1 and in any event the Trustees may send a notice to any member of the Charity by suitable electronic means or in writing either personally or by sending it by pre-paid post or facsimile transmission to her registered address within the United Kingdom supplied by her to the Charity for the purpose of the giving of notice to her.
- 20.3 A notice given by fax or email shall be deemed to have been given at the same time as it is transmitted by the Charity.
- 20.4 A properly addressed and pre-paid notice sent by post shall be deemed to have been given upon the second business day following that on which the notice is posted.
- 20 5 Subject to article 20 1 notice of every general meeting shall be given to:
- 20.5 1 every member
- 20.5.2 the auditors for the time being of the Charity, and
- 20.5.3 each Trustee
  - No other person shall be entitled to receive notices of general meetings but the Trustees may decide to send a notice to any other person.
- It is sufficient to send a notice (by any method authorised by this article 20) giving only 20.6 the general nature of business if the notice notifies the recipient of

20.6.1 the publication of documents published on one or more websites;

- 20.6 2 the website address or addresses; and
- 20 6.3 the place on the website or websites where the further information or documents may be accessed and how they may be accessed.
- 20.7 Sometimes a person entitled to receive a notice of a meeting does not receive it because of accidental omission or some other reason. This does not invalidate the proceedings of that meeting
