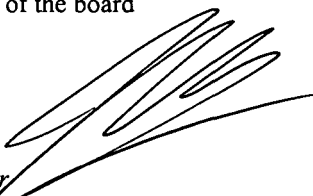
Directors' interests in shares

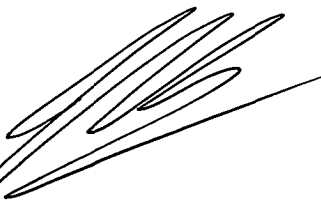
For the period ended 29 September 2017 the company (registration number 02435455) was entitled to exemption under section 480 of the Companies Act 2006.
