The director is responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the company's transactions and disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and enable him to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. She is also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

To assist them in discharging these responsibilities, the directors has engaged a number of third party providers including an accounting firm who is engaged to prepare the company's financial statements, as well as Honeywell International Inc.'s own finance shared service centre located in Bengaluru/Prague/Bucharest. Honeywell operates a country controllership model under which an identified senior finance representative is responsible for all of the UK and Ireland entities, supported by a wider finance team and under the supervision of the Regional Finance Leader for North & South Europe. The director has ensured that adequate processes are in place to maintain oversight and supervision over these various providers and processes and to ensure there is clear linkage with the company's activities.

# 1. Significant accounting policies

These financial statements are prepared on the realisable value of assets and liabilities therein and in accordance with applicable accounting standards in the United Kingdom and the Companies Act 2006.

### Accounting basis

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention.

The company has elected to retain its accounting policies for reported assets, liabilities and equity at the date of transition to FRS102 until there is any change to those balances or the company undertakes any new transactions.

# 2. Cash flow statement and related party transactions

The company is a wholly owned subsidiary company of a group headed by Honeywell International Inc., and is included in the consolidated financial statements of that company, which are publicly available. Consequently, the company has taken advantage of the exemption within FRS 1 "Cash flow statements" (revised 1996) from preparing a cash flow statement.

In accordance with the exemptions available under FRS 8 "Related party disclosures", transactions with other wholly owned undertakings within the Honeywell group are not required to be disclosed in these financial statements, on the grounds that this company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Honeywell International Inc., whose financial statements are publicly available.
