Rent Deposit Deed dated 18 February 2000 made between The Scottish Provident Institution ("the Landlord") (1) and Research Institute for Consumer Affairs and International Consumer Research Testing Limited ("the Tenant") (2).

If the Tenant shall not during the period of fourteen days after the due date pay to the Landlord or its agents the rent interest or any other moneys payable to the Landlord pursuant to a Lease ("the Lease") dated 18 February 2000 and made between the Landlord (1) and the Tenant (2) of ground floor premises at 30 Angel Gate City Road London EC1 then the amount of such rent interest or other moneys as shall from time to time be due and unpaid may be withdrawn from the deposit account by and paid to the Landlord.
