NOTE: 1

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The Accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the Company's and Group's operations which are described in the Directors' Report and all of which are continuing.

1.2 BASIS OF CONSOLIDATION

The Group Accounts consolidate the accounts of Silca Unican (UK) Limited and its subsidiary undertakings for the year to 30 June 1998.

1.3 INVESTMENTS

The equity method of accounting is used to account for the investments in which the company exercises significant influence.

1.4 <u>STOCK</u>

Stock is stated at the lower of Cost and Net Realisable Value.

1.5 TURNOVER

Turnover represents the total income receivable by the company (exclusive of Valued Added Tax) in respect of goods sold and services rendered.

1.6 DEPRECIATION

Depreciation of the following Fixed Assets is provided on a straight line basis in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful working life.

Land and Buildings Leasehold

over the term of the lease.

Fixtures, Fittings and Equipment Plant and Machinery

20% p.a.

Motor Vehicles

20% p.a.

The Depreciation policy has been changed from reducing balance to straight line basis in order to bring it into line with the accounting policy of its parent.

1.7 DEFERRED TAXATION

Deferred taxation is provided at appropriate rates on all timing differences using the liability method only to the extent that, in the opinion of the Directors there is a reasonable probability that a liability will crystallise in the foreseeable future.

1.8 LEASING AND HIRE PURCHASE COMMITMENTS

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts and finance leases are capitalised as tangible assets and depreciated over the shorter of the lease term and their useful lives. Obligations under such agreements are included in creditors net of the finance charge allocated to future periods. The finance element of the rental payment is charged to the profit and loss account so as to produce a constant periodic rate of charge on the net obligation outstanding in each period.

1.9 PENSIONS

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the company to the fund in respect of the year.

1.10 OPERATING LEASES

Rental applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged to the Profit and Loss Account as incurred.

1.11 FOREIGN CURRENCIES

Assets and Liabilities in Foreign Currencies are translated into Sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the Balance Sheet date. Transactions in Foreign Currencies are converted into Sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating results for the year.
