ORDER

UPON the Application of the Applicant

AND UPON reading the witness statement of the Applicant dated 1st April 2010

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1 The Applicant has permission to make a composite application in respect of the Insolvency proceedings identified in the Schedules to this Order
- 2 The proceedings listed in Schedules 3 to 7 inclusive be transferred to the Companies Court of the Chancery Division of the High Court of Justice for the purpose only of this Application and forthwith after the making of the Order be transferred back to the Court from which they came As soon as reasonably practicable after the making of

this Order, the Applicant do lodge with each of the Courts mentioned in Schedules 3 to 7 inclusive one copy of the Order (as sealed) for each case under the jurisdiction of that court for filing on the court file relating to that case

- 3 In respect of the **Creditors Voluntary Liquidations** listed in Schedule 1 pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986

3 1 in each matter the First Respondent be removed as liquidator,

3 2 the Applicant and the Fifth and Twelfth Respondents be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent in each of the matters in Schedule 1 where they are shown as new appointees

And in each matter the First Respondent be released from liability as liquidator pursuant to section 173(2)(c) of the Insolvency Act 1986

- 4 In respect of the **Members Voluntary Liquidations** listed in schedule 2 pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986

4 1 in each matter the First Respondent be removed as liquidator,

4 2 the Fifth Respondent be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent in the matter of Affinity 001 Plc

And in each matter the First Respondent be released from liability as liquidator pursuant to section 173(2)(c) of the Insolvency Act 1986

- 5 In respect of the **Compulsory Liquidations** listed in schedule 3 pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986

5 1 in each matter the First Respondent be removed as liquidator,

5 2 in the matter of Baker Street Media Finance Limited, the Seventeenth Respondent be removed as liquidator,

5 3 the Applicant and the Fifth and Twelfth Respondents be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent in each of the matters in Schedule 3 where they are shown as new appointees

And in each matter the First Respondent be released as liquidator and in the matter of Baker Street Media Finance Limited, the Seventeenth Respondent be released from

liability as liquidator pursuant to section 173(2)(c) of the Insolvency Act 1986

- 6 In respect of the **Administrations** listed in Schedule 4 pursuant to paragraph 88 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986

- 6 1 in each matter the First Respondent be removed as administrator,
6 2 the Applicant and the Fifth, Sixth and Twelfth Respondents be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent in each of the matters in Schedule 4 where they are shown as new appointees

And in each matter the First Respondent be discharged from liability as administrator pursuant to paragraph 98 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986

- 7 In respect of the **Company Voluntary Arrangements** listed in Schedule 5 pursuant to Section 7(5) of the Insolvency Act 1986

- 6 1 in each matter the First Respondent be removed as supervisor,
6 2 in each matter the Applicant be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent

And in each matter the First Respondent be released from liability as supervisor pursuant to the Court's inherent jurisdiction to give directions

- 8 In respect of the **Bankruptcies** listed in Schedule 6 pursuant to Sections 298(1) and 303(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986

- 8 1 in each matter the First Respondent be removed as trustee in bankruptcy,
8 2 in each matter the Applicant be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent

And in each matter the First Respondent be released from liability as trustee in bankruptcy pursuant to Section 299 of the Insolvency Act 1986

- 9 In respect of the **Individual Voluntary Arrangements** listed in Schedule 7 pursuant to Section 263(5) of the Insolvency Act 1986,

- 9 1 the First Respondent be removed as supervisor

9.2 the Applicant and the Fifth Respondent be appointed in substitution for the First Respondent in each of the matters in Schedule 7 where they are shown as new appointees

And in each matter the First Respondent be released from liability as supervisor pursuant to the Court's inherent jurisdiction to give directions

- 10 The respective removals and appointments referred to herein shall be effective from the date of this Order
- 11 There be liberty to each creditor to apply to vary or discharge the Order insofar as it relates to the matter in which they are a creditor, within 28 days of their being given notice of it
- 12 The Applicant shall procure that, at the first convenient opportunity to do so, and in any event within 42 days of the date of the Order, a block advertisement in relation to each of the relevant estates shall be placed in the London Gazette containing notification of the following matters
 - (1) the removal of the First and Seventeenth Respondents and the appointment of, and the name of their replacements,
 - (2) the fact that the creditors have liberty to apply, within 28 days after the notice has been advertised, to vary or discharge the order made,
 - (3) in the case of each bankruptcy and liquidation, that,
 - (a) the costs of complying with a request of the committee or creditor for an account of the First and/or Seventeenth Respondent's administration should be an expense of the insolvency proceedings, and
 - (b) the fact that the creditors have the right to object and make representations to the Secretary of State in respect of the First and/or Seventeenth Respondent's release within 28 days after the notice has been advertised
- 13 In relation to the insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedules hereto, and insofar as the Insolvency Act 1986 or the Insolvency Rules 1986 contain any requirement for

advertisement, the requirement shall be dispensed with save to the extent provided for herein. Insofar as the First and/or Seventeenth Respondent is required by law to give any notice of the removal from office, the Applicant is entitled to sign and send any such notice on his behalf.

14 The order for costs be as follows

- (1) the costs of the Application insofar as attributable to an individual insolvency proceeding are to be fixed and paid in the ordinary way as remuneration costs and expenses of such insolvency,
- (2) costs which cannot be attributed to an individual insolvency proceeding because they affect all the insolvency proceedings are to be apportioned,
- (3) Such costs should not exceed 10% of the assets realised in the particular insolvency or voluntary arrangement
