1.1.2 Cash at bank on appointment

The declaration of solvency detailed cash at bank of £237,392, of which £237,391 was realised.

1.1.3 Corporation tax refund

The declaration of solvency detailed a corporation tax refund due of £56,870, which was realised, together with £91 of interest.

There are no remaining assets to realise.

1.2 Administration and planning

Certain aspects of the work that the Joint Liquidators undertake are derived from the underlying legal and regulatory framework for cases of this nature.
