

- b. the right of the First Respondent to apply to the Secretary of State for his release in respect of the Insolvency appointments listed in Schedules B to R, T, U, and Y to Z(II) within 21 days of the date of the Notice save in respect of claims notified by that date,
- c. the right to the First Respondent to his release in respect of his other appointments listed in Schedules S, V, W and X with effect from 28 days of the date of the Notice save in respect of claims notified by that date,
- d. creditors' rights to call for statements under regulation 11 (in liquidations) or regulation 25 (in bankruptcies) of the Insolvency Regulations 1994,
- e. that where there is a creditors' committee it is open to that committee to require an account of the Respondent's administration and that, where there is no committee, it is open to an individual creditor to apply to the Court within 28 days of the date of the Notice to require such an account
