**NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS**

1. The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable UK accounting standards and on a basis consistent with the previous year.
2. The Company has not traded during the year or the previous year, has incurred no liabilities and, consequently, has made neither profit nor loss. None of the directors received any emoluments in respect of their services to the Company.
3. The Company ceased to be a close company within the meaning of Section 414 of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1988 on 21 April 2008. The Company's immediate parent company is Thomson Information & Solutions Limited. Within the meaning of the Companies Act, Thomson Investments Limited ("TIL") is regarded by the Directors of the Company as being the Company's ultimate parent company and controlling party. Within the meaning of the said Act, The Thomson Corporation ("Thomson") was the parent undertaking of the only group of undertakings for which group accounts were drawn up and of which the Company was a member for the period ended 31 December 2007. On 17 April 2008 Thomson acquired Reuters Group PLC ("Reuters") by implementing a dual listed company structure. Under this structure Thomson Reuters has two parent companies, both of which are publicly listed, Thomson Reuters Corporation ("Thomson Reuters") a Canadian company (formerly known as The Thomson Corporation) and Thomson Reuters PLC being the new English company. On 21 April 2008 the Company was transferred into Thomson Reuters PLC and from this date will be included in the group accounts of Thomson Reuters PLC. TIL, and Thomson Reuters are incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, Canada. Thomson Reuters PLC is incorporated under the laws of England and Wales.
