1. Accounting policies

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with the accounting policies set out below. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with FRS102 Section 1A - The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland and the Companies Act 2006.

Turnover

Turnover comprises the invoiced value of goods and services supplied by the company, net of Value Added Tax made during the year.

Fixed Assets

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost or valuation of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Fixtures and Fittings - 15 % per annum reducing balance Office Equipment - 25% per annum reducing balance

Motor Vehicles - 25% per annum reducing balance

Leasing

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged to profit and loss account as incurred.

Pension Scheme

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme, and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the company to the fund in respect of the year.

4. Creditors due within one year

Creditors include bank loans and overdrafts and net obligations under finance lease and hire purchase contracts which are secured of £37,058 (2019 £25,972). The bank loans and overdrafts are secured by a fixed and floating charge over the company's assets. The finance leases are secured on the assets concerned.

5. Creditors due after more than one year

Creditors include bank loans and net obligations under finance lease and hire purchase contracts which are secured of £51,8 (2019 £56,454). The bank loans are secured by fixed and floating charge over the company's assets. The finance leases are secured on the assets concerned.

6. Pension costs

The company operates a defined contribution scheme for employees. The assets of the scheme are held separately from those of the company in an independently administered fund. In 2020, £38,833 (2019 - £31,047) was contributed.
