TRUSTEES' REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2001

The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31st March 2001.

ACTIVITIES

The company's principal activity is the pursuance of any charitable object calculated to benefit the community, and in particular members of the Chinese community, within the Borough of Islington.

REVIEW OF YEAR

The year has undoubtedly been very tough in the area of funding. Core funding from Islington Council has been substantially reduced since October 2000 and completely stopped in October 2001. Although other sources of funding and donations were found, the overall total funding figure in 2000-01 was still less than the previous year.

In order to overcome this financial shortfall, the Association had to keep a very tight control of its expenditure. This is reflected in its financial accounts as the total expenditure for the year is approximately £42,000 lower than that of last year. The reduction was achieved by effective use of resources and not by compromising on the quality of services provided.

Despite the current financial difficulties, the Association is still able to maintain the commitments to its members and to continue its valuable contributions to the community of Islington and its environs.

FINANCIAL RESULTS

The results for the year are set out on page 5.

STATEMENT OF TRUSTEES' RESPONSIBILITIES

The trustees are required by law to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity as at the end of the financial year and of the income and expenditure of the charity for that period. In preparing those financial statements, the trustees are required to:

select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently; make judgements and estimates that are prudent; follow applicable accounting standards; prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue in business.

The trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the charity and to enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

AUDITORS

The auditors, John Rogers & Co, are willing to stand for re-appointment and a proposal for their re-appointment will be put to the annual general meeting.
