Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective June 2002).

Turnover

Turnover represents the net invoiced sales of goods and services, excluding Value Added Tax, and movements in warranty work provision.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Freehold property

- 2% on cost (buildings only)

Plant and machinery

- 25% on reducing balance and 25% on cost

Fixtures and fittings

- 15% on reducing balance

Stocks

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and ne: realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date,

Research and development

Expenditure on research and development is written off in the year in which it is incurred.

Pensions

Pension contributions payable for the year are charged in the profit and loss account.
