1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

1.2 Turnover

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents licence fees and ground rents receivable, and plant room sales during the year.

1.3 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Leasehold Property

To reduce the value of the head lease to its estimated residual value

Furniture & equipment

15% straight line

1.4 Stocks

Property developed with a view to resale is identified as stock and stated at the lower of cost and net realisable value after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items. Cost includes the cost of development, including directly attributable fees and expenses.

1.5 Operating leases

Rentals under operating leases are charged to the Profit and loss account on a straight line basis over the lease term.

1.6 Deferred taxation

Deferred tax is provided in full on material timing differences which result in an obligation at the balance sheet date to pay more tax, or a right to pay less tax, at a future date, at rates expected to apply when they crystalise based on current tax rates and legislation. Timing differences arise from the inclusion of items of income and expenditure in taxation computations in periods different from those in which they are included in the accounts.

Deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is regarded as more likely than not that they will be recovered. On the ground of immateriality deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.
