1 Principal Accounting Policies

Accounting Convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective March 2000).

Going Concern

After making enquiries, and taking into account the losses made in the year and the current liabilities position at 31st December 1999, the directors have received a letter of support from the parent undertaking stating that the company will be provided with adequate financial resources by its parent undertaking to continue in operations for the foreseeable future. For this reason the directors continue to adopt the going concern basis in preparing the accounts.

Turnover

Turnover is the total amount receivable by the company for goods supplied and services provided, excluding VAT and trade discounts.

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated to write down the cost, less estimated residual value, of all tangible fixed assets over their expected useful lives. The rates generally applicable are:
