#### 3. OBJECTS

The charity's objects are specifically restricted to the following for the public benefit:

- 3.1 to relieve people in need and their families, dependants and/or carers, where such need is due to disadvantages including:
  - 3.1.1 addiction and other dependencies, including alcohol and drug misuse and gambling;
  - 3.1.2 mental and physical ill health, including serious mental illness, poor psychological and emotional well-being, learning disabilities, and the effects of high-pressure work environments (including in particular the military and emergency services);
  - 3.1.3 age;
  - 3.1.4 having been offenders and/or being at risk of offending;
  - 3.1.5 social exclusion;
  - 3.1.6 poverty:
  - 3.1.7 having complex and/or co-occurring needs across one or more of the preceding categories;

by means including (but not limited to):

- 3.1.8 the provision of treatment, care, advice, advocacy, support, information and counselling to such persons;
- 3.1.9 assistance in the rehabilitation and recovery of such persons;
- 3.1.10 the reduction or prevention of harms and the causes of harms associated with such need, including by the provision of interventions and other treatment;
- 3.1.11 the provision of training and employment opportunities; and
- 3.1.12 working with and in the communities where such need is identified to alleviate any disadvantage, inequality, prejudice and discrimination contributing to such need.
- 3.2 to advance the education:
  - 3.2.1 and training of any person in the care or treatment of people in need as described in Article 2.1; and
  - 3.2.2 of the public in all aspects of such need including the manner by which it is both caused and alleviated.
