1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities effective April 2008.

Turnover policy

Turnover represents the total amount receivable for services provided in the year, excluding value added tax.

Tangible assets depreciation policy

Depreciation is provided to write off each asset over its estimated useful life at an annual rate of 1/3rd of cost.

Valuation information and policy

Fixed asset investments are stated in the balance sheet at cost less any provision for impairment in value. Such investments are classified as (tangible) fixed assets.

Current asset investments are stated in the balance sheet at cost less any provision for impairment in value. Such investments are classified as current assets (stocks) when regarded as available for sale.
