(e) A receipts and payments account is attached, showing realisations to date. The majority of the Company's assets were sold for a consideration of £50,000 under a sale agreement dated 30 July 2004, to S P Angel &Co. Limited. Legal fees of £14,404 were paid to solicitors Edwin Coe for assisting with the sale agreement and advising on the appointment of the Joint Administrators.

(f) Assets that remain to be realised:

The statement of affairs as at 23 July 2004 showed debtors and prepayments of uncertain value, and further collections are expected. £10,000 is shown as due from Proactive Games Limited and approximately £18,000 remains to be collected from the Company's bank accounts. It is possible that further realisations will be achieved depending on claims which may be brought by the liquidator in respect of prior transactions. Until investigations into the business of the Company before the commencement of the Administration are concluded, it is not possible to estimate the nature or value of such claims.

(g) The Administration is now moving to creditors voluntary liquidation.
