#### 1) **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

### Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities.

### Turnover

Turnover will represent the net amount of invoices to third parties, excluding VAT.

### Tangible Fixed Assets

Depreciation is provided, at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Freehold Buildings 2% On Cost

15% On Written Down Value Plant and Machinery - 15% On Written Down Value
Tixtures and Fittings - 10% On Written Down Value
25% On Written Down Value Plant and Machinery 25% On Written Down Value

### Stocks

Stocks and Work in Progress are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

### Deferred Taxation

Provision is made at current rates for taxation deferred in respect of all material timing differences except to the extent that, in the opinion of the Directors, there is reasonable probability that the liability will not arise in the foreseeable future. Deferred taxation not provided in the accounts amount to £100. (1998-£100).

### Research and Development

Expenditure on research and development is written off in the year in which it is incurred.

# Foreign Currencies

Assets and Liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the Balance Sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating profit.

### Pension Costs

Contributions in respect of the Company's defined contribution pension scheme are charged to the Profit and Loss account for the year in which they are payable.
