#### 1 Accounting policies

#### Basis of preparation

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

#### Turnover

Turnover represents the amount derived from subscriptions to the association and other sales and services provided stated net of value added tax. Where the association enters into projects at no profit margin, revenue is recognised in line with costs in the period.

#### Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets so as to write off the cost or valuation, less any estimated residual value, over their expected useful economic life as follows

#### Asset class

#### Depreciation method and rate

#### Stock

Stock of stationery is valued at cost

#### Foreign currency

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange prevailing at the accounting date. Transactions in foreign currencies are recorded at the date of the transactions. All differences are taken to the Income and Expenditure account.

#### Hire purchase and leasing

Rentals payable under operating leases are charged against income on a straight line basis over the lease term

#### Pensions

The pension costs charged in the financial statements represent the contribution payable by the association during the year

#### 4 Merger

The business assets of Energy Retail Association and UK Business Council for Sustainable Energy were acquired on 2nd April 2012 Following the acquisition the three entities merged to form the Association of Electricity Producers trading as Energy UK UKBCSE is in the process of being liquidated and it is expected that the remaining assets will be transferred within the next year ERA and its subsidiary are in the process of being made dormant, any remaining assets will also be transferred
