



1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied.

Compliance with International Financial Reporting Standards

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) and interpretations (IFRICs) issued by the Interpretations Committee, as published by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB). They are also in accordance with IFRS and IFRIC interpretations endorsed by the European Union. These policies have been consistently applied.

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. They are stated in pounds sterling, the currency of the country in which the Company is incorporated.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

Particulars of the Company's share capital were as follows:

The issued share capital of the Company is £2, (2014: £2), comprising 2 (2014: 2) ordinary shares of £1 each.

3. ULTIMATE HOLDING COMPANY

The parent of the Company is Barclays Group Holdings Limited. The parent undertaking of the smallest group that presents consolidated financial statements is Barclays Bank PLC. The ultimate holding company and the parent company of the largest group that presents group financial statements is Barclays PLC. Both companies are incorporated in the United Kingdom and registered in England.
