Report of the director for the year ended 31 December 2010

The director presents his report together with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2010

Results

The company did not trade during the year, and accordingly no profit and loss account has been included in these financial statements

Principal activities, trading review and future developments

The principal activity of the company is that of a holding company to GSE Lining Technology Limited, a company which was engaged in the year in the manufacture and supply of geosynthetic lining systems and products

The manufacturing operations of GSE Lining Technology Limited ceased on 30 June 2010, following a decision to service UK customers by sourcing products from GSE Corporate resources in other parts of the world GSE Lining Technology Limited continued to trade, without manufacturing its own products, until 31 December 2010 The GSE Lining Technology Limited trade and related assets and liabilities were then transferred to fellow group companies on 1 January 2011, at which point GSE Lining Technology Limited ceased its trading activities Although the subsidiary company reported a loss in 2010, in light of the net asset value of GSE Lining Technology Limited as of 31 December 2010, together with the interest earned in 2011 and on-going into 2012 on a loan to the US parent company, the director has concluded that the fixed asset investment value in the operating company has not been impaired
