ORDER

UPON the application of Antony David Nygate and Geoffrey Stuart Kinlan dated 9 March 2007

AND UPON reading the evidence

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Applicants

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The proceedings listed in Schedule A attached hereto be transferred to the Companies Court of the Chancery Division of the High Court of Justice for the purpose only of considering and if thought fit making the orders contained in paragraphs 2 to 15 of this Application Notice, and the Applicants do ensure that a sealed copy of every order transferring any case to the High Court and of every order which may be made as a result of this application be lodged with the court having jurisdiction over each case affected by such order for filling on the court file relating to that case
- In relation to all the proceedings listed in Schedule B to Schedule F attached hereto, the First Respondent be removed from office with effect from the date of this Order.
- 3. In relation to the members' voluntary liquidations identified in Schedule B attached hereto, the First Applicant be appointed as joint liquidator of the companies with effect from the date of this Order in place of the First Respondent and serve as joint liquidator with the Second Applicant.
- 4. In relation to the creditors' voluntary liquidations identified in Schedule C attached hereto, the First Applicant be appointed as joint liquidator of the companies with effect from the date of this Order in place of the First Respondent and serve as joint liquidator with the Second Applicant.
- In relation to the company voluntary arrangements identified in Schedule D attached hereto, the First Applicant be appointed as joint supervisor of the arrangements with effect from the date of this Order in place of the First Respondent and serve as joint supervisor with the Second Applicant.
- 6. In relation to the administration identified in Schedule E attached hereto, the First Applicant be appointed as joint administrator of the company with effect from the date of this Order in place of the First Respondent and serve as joint administrator with the Second Applicant.
- In relation to the bankruptcy identified in Schedule F attached hereto, the Second Applicant be appointed as the sole trustee of the bankrupt's estate with effect from the date of this Order in place of the First Respondent.
- 8. The First Respondent be released from all liability in relation to his conduct as supervisor of the estates listed in Schedule D with effect from 28 days after the relevant notice referred to in paragraph 12 below has been given, save in respect of any claim notified by that date.
- Pursuant to paragraph 98 to Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, the First Respondent be released from all liability both in respect of acts and omissions

of his in the administration and otherwise in relation to his conduct as administrator of the company in administration referred to in Schedule E with effect from 28 days after the relevant notice referred to in paragraph 12 below has been given, save in respect of any claim notified by that date.

- The First Respondent shall not be at liberty to apply to the Secretary of State for his release in respect of the insolvency appointments listed in Schedules B, C and F until after the expiry of 21 days from the date when the relevant notice referred to in paragraph 12 below has been given, save in respect of any claim notified by that date.
- 11. In relation to each appointment listed in the Schedules B to F attached hereto, the creditors have liberty to apply to vary or discharge the order of the Court (insofar as it relates to an estate of which he is a creditor) within 28 days of the date of the notice referred to in paragraph 12 below.
- 12. The Second Respondent give notice of this Order to all creditors of the estates listed in the Schedules B to F within 28 days of the date of this Order by means of an advertisement in the London Gazette (the "Notice"). The Notice shall explain:
 - a. the effect of the Order made and that all creditors have permission to apply for reconsideration of the Order provided that any such application is made within 28 days of the date of the Notice;
 - the right of the First Respondent to apply to the Secretary of State for his release in respect of the insolvency appointments listed in B, C and F within 21 days of the date of the Notice, save in respect of claims notified by that date;
 - c. the right to the First Respondent to his release in respect of his other appointments listed in Schedules D & E with effect from 28 days of the date of the Notice, save in respect of claims notified by that date;
 - d. creditors' rights to call for statements under regulation 11 (in liquidations),
 or regulation 25 (in bankruptcies) of the Insolvency Regulations 1994;
 - e. that where there is a creditors' committee it is open to that committee to require an account of the First Respondent's administration and that, where there is no committee, it is open to an individual creditor to apply to the Court within 28 days of the date of the Notice to require such an account.
- 13. The time for service of notice of the Application on Mr C Steele pursuant to rule 2.122 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 ("the Rules") be abridged to 4 days.

- 14. The costs of and incidental to this Application be paid for by the Second Respondent
- 15. There be liberty to apply
