The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed a debt totalling £1 due from Innovata Limited. During the liquidation, the Company received distributions from subsidiaries (also in members' voluntary liquidation) which totalled £3 and was effected by the distribution in specie to the Company of debts totalling £3 due from Innovata Limited. Prior to the conclusion of the Company's liquidation the liquidators distributed in specie the £4 intercompany receivable to Andaris Group Limited, the sole shareholder of the Company (see "Distributions" below).

The Company had no known creditors. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in the London Gazette on 19 December 2017. No creditors were forthcoming as a result of this advertisement.

Tax

The Company's tax advisors advised that the Company had dormant corporation tax status. A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT matters.

Distributions

On 12 September 2018 the Joint Liquidators declared a first and final distribution of the assets of the Company to Andaris Group Limited, as the sole beneficial shareholder of the Company.

The distribution was at the rate of £4 per 10 pence Ordinary share and was effected by assignment of the debt of £4 due to the Company by Innovata Limited.
