Auditors' report to the directors of UK Highways M40 (Holdings) Limited pursuant to Section 173 (5) of the Companies Act 1985

We have examined the attached statutory declaration of the directors dated 28 April 2000 in connection with the company's proposed purchase of ordinary shares by a payment of £7,477,026 out of the capital of the company.
