DRAFT ORDER

UPON THE Application dated 26th July 2006

AND UPON THE Petition presented to this Court on 27 July 2006

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Applicant, the Administrator ("the Administrator") of Goe Limited ("the Company")

AND UPON READING the documents placed before the Court

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

1. Paragraph 1 of the Order of Mr Justice Rimer of 23 April 2002 be varied so as to extend the administration to 20 November 2006.
2. The costs of and incidental to the Application be an expense of the administration of the Company.
3. The Administration Order be discharged forthwith.
4. The costs and expenses of the administration be paid out of the assets of the Company.

5. The Administrator of the Company be released from liability under section 20 of the Insolvency Act 1986 fourteen days after filing his Receipts and Payments account under Insolvency Rule 2.52.
6. The Company be wound up by this Court under the provisions of The Insolvency Act 1986.
7. The costs of and incidental to the Petition be an expense of administration.
