DIRECTOR'S REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

1. PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY

The principal activity of the company continued to be the development, marketing and support, on a worldwide basis, of International Multi-Currency Financial and Distribution and Consolidation software.

2. REVIEW OF BUSINESS

Resulting from the development of FALCON, (the Group Consolidation and Reporting Software) with Touche Ross Management Consultancy, who have provided their expertise and experience of implementing group reporting systems the company undertook to position itself as one of the three leading international software companies operating in this market segment.

This has entailed a strategic shift in resources in the areas of manpower, marketing and finance towards the FALCON product to gain market profile and market share. This strategy has now borne fruit and the company is pleased to report that the first period of 1995 has shown a significant profit surge notwithstanding the increase in staffing of highly qualified staff for the FALCON product.

Our continuing research and development programme involves the use of state of the art technology including Windows/SQL and enterprise wide client server compatibility.

3. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

Since it's formation in 1983 the company has incurred major expenditure in the development of all its product range including FALCON, all of which has been written off to the profit and loss account and thus has a significant impact on short term profitability in 1994.

4. EVENTS SINCE THE YEAR END

As previously indicated the company has had a very successful first period of 1995, partly due to being awarded a major multi site contract for DWS range of accounting products from a major US firm of Management Consultancy to replace all their financial legacy systems in all 20 countries outside North America.

5. OVERSEAS OPERATIONS

The company continues to develop its agency network outside Europe and currently supports its products in over 50 countries worldwide.
