The «Redemptoris Mater House of Formation» has been established with the general object of promoting religion in accordance with the Roman Catholic faith and more specifically of training young man and adults as missionary priests for the Catholic Church, running a suitable religious house for that purpose.

The Company is occupying a property known as St. Edward's Convent, situated in 11 Harewood Avenue, London NW1 6LD, where 16 to 20 seminarians from a number of countries of Europe, Asia, and America have been residing full board, while attending classes of philosophy and theology at Allen Hall, the Seminary of the Catholic Diocese of Westminster.

During this period the Company has provided the beneficiaries with food and lodging, met their expenses (as studies, clothing, health care, travelling in London and abroad, etc.) and offered them a training program based on several activities including field-work experiences in London and abroad.

The House of Formation is run under the supervision and responsibility of Fr Francesco Donega, member of and chairman of both the Administrative and the Pastoral Council. Administrative work is carried out by other Members of the Administrative Council. Activities like cleaning, cooking and maintenance depend on the service of voluntary helpers. A caretaker has been employed since February 1996, together with his wife.

The charity funds come only from voluntary donations. No fund raising activities have been undertaken in UK or abroad. The reason for such a policy was the uncertainty about the future of the House of Formation, which depends on certain decisions of the Archbishop of Westminster. During financial year 96-97 donations cover only 21.26% of the expenses. The deficit was covered by reserves from previous years.

Charity funds have been used exclusively for:

- i) covering the costs of the maintenance of the house (rent, electricity, gas, water, telephone, repairs, etc.)
- ii) paying for food, travel, school and any other expenses necessary to ensure adequate living conditions for the beneficiaries.

The plan for the immediate future is to continue running the House for the academic year 1997-98, providing the 17 students attached to it with all required for studies, pastoral activities and field-work training in UK and abroad. Further activities are still subject to decisions by the Archbishop of Westminster.
