(3) Deferred axation

Provision is made under the liability method in respect of those timing differences which are expected to become payable in the foreseeable "unite."

(4) Leased assa-s

Payment=under operating leases are charged agensti profits in the year the payments are made.

(5) Contract_d∈ttors

The costsincurred in respect of services under inscontract during the period prior to the prison becoming available for occupation are remunerated over the remaining contract term.

Accordingly these costs are accumulated within contract debtors as incurred. Availability fees will be allocated between turnover and reimbursemen of contract debtors so as to generate a constant rate of refur nover the life of the contract.

(6) Restater en of 1997

The restate ment of the accounts is due to a change in interpretation of the accounting policy relating to the contract debtor. Interest, previously expensed, is now capitalised as part of the contract lebtor in accordance with note 1(5).

Under the erms of a contract with Tarmac Construction Limited dated 20 December 1995, the company is committed to payments totalling £7,05000 for major maintenance works over the remaining to irract term.

An operating agreement with Group 4 Prison Services Limited was signed by the company on 20 December 1995. The company is committed to pay fixed and variable fees to Group 4 Prison Services Limited based on the number of available prisoner places for the remaining contract term. Payments in the year ended 31 December 1998 were £12,181,312 (1997 - £826,636).

12 RELATEL PARTY DISCLOSURES

In addition to the contracted commitments set out in note 11 above, Group 4 Prison Services Limited provided admin strative and technical services es to the company during the year at a cost of £135,335 1997 - £34,784). Similar services were provided by companies related to Tarmac (PFI) Limited at a cost of £82,463 (1997 - £75,503).

13 PARENT JMDERTAKINGS

The company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Group 4 Tarmac (Fazakerley) limited, a company which file= consolidated financial statements in En-land. The share cepital of Group 4 Tarmac (Fazakerley) Limited is held fifty percent by Tarma (PFI) Limited, which is registered in the United Kingdom, with the other fifty percent held by Group 4 Prison Services Limitec, a company incorpora act in the United Kingdom.
