



- Given the significant level of potential realisations still to be completed, the Administrators concluded that it was appropriate to extend each of these
- A Court Order was obtained on 3 April 2009 to extend the initial period of the administrations (which were to end on 13 April 2009). The administrations of the Parent company and Operating entities were extended until 13 October 2010, and the administrations of the dormant companies were extended until 13 April 2010.
- The Administrators are in the process of making a distribution in full to preferential creditors in the relevant Operating entities (see page 12)
- We have updated our estimates of the extent of the Prescribed Parts which may result from forecast floating charge realisations and these are detailed on page 13. The Court has granted permission to distribute the Prescribed Part to the unsecured creditors in the Administrations of the Operating entities

## Summary of progress by division since appointment

Building Consultancy Division

Following the sale of most of these businesses, we are continuing to collect the outstanding trade receivables and certain deferred consideration.

Professional Services and Commercial Management Divisions

Following the sale of seven business we are continuing to pursue outstanding trade receivables and to deal with trust monies retained within these

EG Plc and head office function

The disposals to Caley and certain other business sales required that the Administrators maintained a head office function for a period under a transitional services agreement. The central services maintained include IT facilities, human resources, payroll, accounting and other services. The costs of these These arrangements were concluded in October 2008 as the transfer of services was complete. The final recharges due to EG plc have been agreed and transitional services, which are shown in the Receipts and Payments Accounts contained in Appendix 2, are being borne by the relevant counterparty.

EMS

Following the transfer of certain contracts and 300 employees from EMS to the Repairs Division, we are continuing to pursue outstanding trade

Dormant companies

- The administrators concluded the administrations of 29 of the dormant subsidiaries in April 2009 and these companies have proceeded to be dissolved.

- Further investigations are continuing into the affairs of the remaining 18 dormant companies which are delaying the conclusion of these administrations



### Asset realisations

The majority of receivable balances have been realised although there are still a few active workstreams which represent opportunities to profitably increase floating charge realisations.

#### Trade Receivables

- To date, £9.2 million has been recovered from trade receivables.
- Our specialist receivables realisation team has continued to pursue debtor amounts and has exceeded our previous estimate of target realisations (£9.1 m) This result has been achieved through the sale of several rump ledgers and the settlement of several legal claims since the last report.
- Forecast realisations are expected to be low from this point onwards as the receivables realisations team has been exiting workstreams which do not represent profitable opportunities leaving only a small number of active workstreams.

#### Client account receivables

- [Client account receivables total £2.2 million across four entities and eight separate ledgers. Identifying this client account debt and the managing agents has been a very time consuming process
- To date, £902,000 has been recovered from this source.

There are numerous property related matters still to be concluded and property interests to be realised.

### Leasehold and freehold property

- The sale of business agreements included the interest in 78 of the Group's 154 premises. Of these, 11 are still occupied under licence whilst assignments are being sought.
- 65 leases were not included in sale of business agreements and we have agreed surrenders on 15 of these properties. Acceptance of surrender is awaited from the remaining 50 landlords. These properties remain vacant. Landlords are not under any obligation to accept surrender of the leases. Therefore, some ongoing management and maintenance of public liability cover of the properties may be required until the lease liabilities are discharged.
- Agents were unable to secure premiums for any of the leases. Therefore, we are no longer marketing these interests.

- Unfortunately, the Administrators still do not anticipate any return to the preferential creditors of EG Plc.
- In April notices of the intention to pay a preferential dividend were circulated to all creditors which the Administrators considered had a preferential debt, namely former employees and the RPO, against Building Consultancy, ECPS and ECS. In August the same notice was circulated to the preferential creditors of EMS.

However, in the cases of ECPS and ECS the Administrators preferential distribution will be made
- In the case of Building Consultancy all preferential claims have now been agreed and a distribution in full will be made in November 2009
- The Administrators are currently in the process of agreeing the preferential claims with a view to making a distribution in full before the year end



### Liabilities (cont.)

The Administrators anticipate that the only return to unsecured creditors will be from the Prescribed Part.

#### Prescribed Part

- The Prescribed Part across the Group is estimated to total £1.327 million based on forecast realisations. Please refer to the table below for the division between companies:
- The Prescribed Part is a fund set aside for the unsecured creditors of the Group from floating charge funds of approximately 20% of net assets, up to a maximum of £600,000 in each estate.

These estimates of the Prescribed Part are based on the current view of the estimated outcome in each administration. The Administrators continue to review the outcome for each entity and as realisations increase the actual amount of the Prescribed Part payable, subject to the maximum of £600,000, may well change.

#### Unsecured creditors

- On 3 April 2009 the Court granted the Joint Administrators permission to pay a dividend to the unsecured creditors from the Prescribed Parts. Accordingly, the Joint Administrators are in the process of agreeing claims in order to declare a dividend to the unsecured creditors of each relevant entity in due course.
- As advised in the Statement of Administrators' proposals under Paragraph 49, the Administrators do not anticipate there will be any return to unsecured creditors other than via the Prescribed Part.
- As in the case of the preferential distribution it remains uncertain whether there will be sufficient floating charge property to facilitate a return to the unsecured creditors by virtue of a Prescribed Part in the case of ECPS and ECS.
- The administrators are currently in the process of agreeing the unsecured claims of Building Consultancy with a view to distributing the maximum Prescribed Part of £600,000 as soon as possible. Until the total value of claims agreed is known it is not possible to specify the quantum of this dividend.
- In the case of EMS the process of agreeing unsecured claims is in progress. However, as the Prescribed Part has not yet been quantified it is not possible to give an indication as to the likely quantum or timing of this dividend payment at present.



#### Other matters

The Administrators continue to reconcile the client account funds and return monies based on proposals circulated to beneficial owners as they are identified.

However, they are now considering alternative methods of returning the remaining funds to clients once and for all.

In total £2.4 million of client funds is still held by the Administrators.



- Since the last report the Joint Administrators and their staff have performed additional reconciliation work on the client accounts which has enabled us to allocate funds to specific clients.
