#### **EMPHASIS OF MATTER**

"In forming our opinion on the financial statements, which is not modified, we have considered the Basis of Preparation paragraph in the Accounting Policies on page 7 concerning the company's ability to continue as a going concern. As explained the company has taken steps to demerge its activities into two separate companies with the result that it will cease to trade in the foreseeable future. As a consequence of this the financial statements have been drawn up on a basis other than that of a going concern. Adjustments were made in the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2009 to write down assets to net realisable values as a result of the decision to demerge the activities of the company being made before those financial statements were approved by the directors. No provision has been made for costs in the current year relating to the future termination of the business as there were no such commitments outstanding at the balance sheet date. Costs incurred of £48,250 relating to this decision have been expensed during the year."

### **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

## ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention

#### BASIS OF PREPARATION

During the year the company initiated its plans to transfer the business of F O Architects Limited to two separate companies owned by the directors individually. The demerger process commenced on 28th April 2011 and is currently ongoing. As a part of this transfer all contractual obligations will be met and subsequent to this the company will become dormant. As a consequence the financial statements have been prepared on a basis other than that of a going concern which includes, where appropriate, writing down assets to their net realisable values. The financial statements do not include any provision for the future termination of the business of the company as there were no such commitments at the balance sheet date. Costs incurred during the year of £48,250 which relate to this decision have been expensed in the year. An adjustment of £83,044 was made in the financial statements for the year end 31 March 2009 to write down the leasehold improvements to their net realisable value.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No 1 from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small company

#### **TURNOVER**

Turnover is recognised as contract activity progresses. Where the substance of a contract is that a right to consideration does not arise until the occurrence of a critical event, revenue is not recognised until that event occurs. Amounts recognised in turnover in excess of billings are recorded on the balance sheet as amounts recoverable on contracts. To the extent that payments on account exceed relevant turnover, the excess is included as a creditor.

#### TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows

Improvements to short leasehold buildings

10% on a straight line basis

Plant and machinery

20% on a straight line basis

Fixtures, fittings & equipment

15% on a straight line basis

As noted above improvements to short leasehold buildings were impaired in the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2010. No further impairments are required as the directors do not consider the net realisable value to be materially different from the net book values shown in note 1.

#### LEASING

All other leases are 'operating leases' and the annual rentals are charged to profit and loss on a straight line basis over the lease term

#### **PENSIONS**

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme for certain employees. The assets of the schemes are held separately from those of the company. The annual contributions payable are charged to the profit and loss account

#### **DEFERRED TAXATION**

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date where transactions or events that result in an obligation to pay more tax in the future or a right to pay less tax in the future have occurred at the balance sheet date. Timing differences are differences between the company's taxable profits and its results as stated in the financial statements that arise from the inclusion of gains and losses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in the financial statements.

# ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

## FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSLATION

Assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated at the rate of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are recorded at the rate ruling at the date of the transaction. All differences are taken to the profit and loss account.
