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THE DIRECTORS' REPORT

YEAR ENDED 31ST JULY 2013

The directors present their report and the financial statements of the group for the year ended 31st July 2013

PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES AND BUSINESS REVIEW

The principal activities of the group during the year were operating residential and nursing care homes, management of freehold investment property and property development and construction

The reported loss for the year of £1,022,086, includes a number of one-off transactions including, £728,821 impairment charge against the Walberton Care Home property following the closure of the business in preparation for redevelopment of the site. The property as at the balance sheet date is valued in accordance with the latest professional valuation on a closed basis. The directors are confident that the redevelopment plans will see this provisional loss (the impairment provision) fully reversed, £171,667 backdated depreciation charge for year ended 31 July 2012 as required by FRS15 Please refer to note 12 for further details in respect of the freehold property depreciation charges

Further to these one-off costs, the reported loss figure also includes £254,203 in relation to the onerous ongoing interest rate hedge commitments that are the subject of the Financial Conduct Authority mis-selling review (please see Future Developments below)

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

The group awaits further developments with regards to its complaint against RBS with regards to the mis-selling of hedges (interest rate protection instruments). The complaint is included in the wider Financial Conduct Authority (formerly the Financial Services Authority) led review

In relation to these specific hedges that are under review, the group has to date incurred losses amounting to circa £2m of which circa £254,203 is included within the £539,735 interest payable figure shown on the profit and loss account for the year ended 31 July 2013

Initial advice has been received that leads the directors to believe that there is a strong likelihood that redress will be received. The directors have been informed by RBS that following the formal recorded meetings which have already taken place between the bank, the directors and the company's legal advisors, the bank's judgement on the case will be made available to them in a matter of weeks

In respect of the loss making former Southern Cross homes that have attributed to the loss reported for the year ended 31 July 2013, the directors can confirm that at the time of signing this report, that the homes are now trading profitably or have since been closed or lease transferred to another operator therefore stemming any further losses

RESULTS AND DIVIDENDS

The loss for the year amounted to £1,022,086 Particulars of dividends paid are detailed in note 11 to the financial statements

FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES AND POLICIES

The group has an established, structured approach to risk management. The group's activities expose it to a variety of financial risks, including the effects of credit, along with liquidity and cash flow risk. The group has adopted risk management policies that seek to mitigate these risks in a cost effective manner.

Credit risk is the risk of loss in the value of financial assets due to counterparties failing to meet all or part of their obligations. The group performs ongoing credit evaluation of its customers' financial condition.

Liquidity risk is the risk that the group does not have sufficient liquid assets to meet its obligations as they fall due Liquidity is maintained at a prudent level and the group ensures there is an adequate liquidity buffer to cover contingencies. The group maintains sufficient cash and open committed credit lines from its bank for its funding requirements.

Interest rate risk re unfavourable movements in interest rates is not perceived as being material to the accounts due to the borrowing agreements in place

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, modified to include the revaluation of certain fixed assets

Basis of consolidation

The consolidated financial statements incorporate the financial statements of the company and all group undertakings. These are adjusted, where appropriate, to conform to group accounting policies. Acquisitions are accounted for under the acquisition method and goodwill on consolidation is capitalised and written off over five years from the year of acquisition. The results of companies acquired or disposed of are included in the profit and loss account after or up to the date that control passes respectively. As a consolidated profit and loss account is published, a separate profit and loss account for the parent company is omitted from the group financial statements by virtue of section 408 of the Companies Act 2006.

Turnover

Turnover represents the value of goods sold and services provided during the year net of discounts, returns and Value Added Tax

For goods sold, turnover is recognised when the goods are physically received by the customer and for services provided, turnover is recognised to the extent that and when there is a right to consideration

Fixed assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows

Plant & machinery - 4 to 5 years straight line Fixtures & fittings - 3 to 5 years straight line Motor vehicles - 25% reducing balance Office equipment - 3 years straight line Freehold property - 50 years straight line

An amount equal to the excess of the annual depreciation charge on revalued assets over the notional historical cost depreciation charge on those assets is transferred annually from the revaluation reserve to the profit and loss reserve

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Investment properties

Investment properties are shown at their open market value. The surplus or deficit arising from the annual revaluation is transferred to the investment revaluation reserve unless a deficit, or its reversal, on an individual investment property is expected to be permanent, in which case it is recognised in the profit and loss account for the year.

This is in accordance with SSAP 19 which, unlike the Companies Act 2006, does not require depreciation of investment properties. Investment properties are held for their investment potential and not for use by the company and so their current value is of prime importance. The departure from the provisions of the Act is required in order to give a true and fair view.

Work in progress

Work in progress is valued on the basis of direct costs plus attributable overheads based on normal level of activity. Provision is made for any foreseeable losses where appropriate. No element of profit is included in the valuation of work in progress.

Operating lease agreements

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged against profits on a straight line basis over the period of the lease

Deferred taxation

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date where transactions or events have occurred at that date that will result in an obligation to pay more, or a right to pay less or to receive more tax, with the following exceptions

Provision is made for tax on gains arising from the revaluation (and similar fair value adjustments) of fixed assets, and gains on disposal of fixed assets that have been rolled over into replacement assets, only to the extent that, at the balance sheet date, there is a binding agreement to dispose of the assets concerned. However, no provision is made where, on the basis of all available evidence at the balance sheet date, it is more likely than not that the taxable gain will be rolled over into replacement assets and charged to tax only where the replacement assets are sold

Deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that the directors consider that it is more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the future reversal of the underlying timing differences can be deducted

Deferred tax is measured on an undiscounted basis at the tax rates that are expected to apply in the periods in which timing differences reverse, based on tax rates and laws enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Financial instruments

Financial liabilities and equity instruments are classified according to the substance of the contractual arrangements entered into. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the entity after deducting all of its financial liabilities.

Where the contractual obligations of financial instruments (including share capital) are equivalent to a similar debt instrument, those financial instruments are classed as financial liabilities. Financial liabilities are presented as such in the balance sheet. Finance costs and gains or losses relating to financial liabilities are included in the profit and loss account. Finance costs are calculated so as to produce a constant rate of return on the outstanding liability.
