# THE FRIENDS OF CASTLE SYCHROV (UK) LIMITED REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2013

The Trustees who are Directors for company law purposes present their Report to the members with the Accounts and Notes thereto.

### **GOVERNING INSTRUMENT**

The Company is a Registered Charity and is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association. The object of the Charity is to preserve and restore Castle Sychrov in the Czech Republic, its historic contents and the parkland surrounding and belonging to it for public appreciation. There have been no changes in the Charity's objects or policies during the year other than a running down of activities prior to the closing of the charity.

### **REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES**

The Charity's final year of activities was focused on just two fund-raising events to support the restoration and conservation of Sychrov Castle and its Park. On 10<sup>th</sup> April the UK Friends organised a closing event at the Embassy of the Czech Republic in London to celebrate Sychrov and the work of the Friends over more than 20 years. Our Chairman, Nicholas Thompson, gave an illustrated talk, 'Castle Sychrov: Supporting a Romantic Cause in Bohemia', which outlined the history and achievements of the UK Friends and its founder, the late Gräfin Marguerite Kottulinsky Rohan. This was followed by a buffet supper. In early October there was a last Friends' trip to Castle Sychrov, preceded by a visit to Český Krumlov and the Baroque Music Festival there. Both events were very well attended and generated funds for the Charity.

Sychrov itself hosts many events which also bring in vital revenue not covered by these Accounts; but this has continued to be severely affected by the world-wide economic recession. Overall responsibility for the property lies with the Castle's Director, Dr Miloš Kadlec.

The UK Friends continued to derive income from members' subscriptions, donations, interest, sales of cards and booklets; and with profit from the Czech trip and the London event this totalled £9,750.

The UK Friends' administration expenses during the year amounted to £824.

The Charity made a grant of £11,500 to Castle Sychrov on 5<sup>th</sup> September, to support work in the Park and the restoration of lost carved work in the Saloon of the Castle.

An Annual General Meeting (for 2012) was held in January 2013; but there has been no subsequent AGM, as the Charity is closing. The Trustees and Committee met twice during the year; and Trustees and various Committee members met informally at other times. The Charity will continue to direct funds, including those raised by a closing appeal, towards the two projects referred to above.

Note: As earlier reported, the Charity's Trustees and organising Committee had reviewed the situation at the end of 2012 following the death of the Charity's founder and special advisor, Marguerite Kottulinsky Rohan. As there was no obvious successor to take over her role, it was decided that the Friends' activities, after more than twenty years, should be drawn to a close at the end of 2013. This was announced to members at the Annual General Meeting in January 2013. The final closing procedures will take place in 2014.
