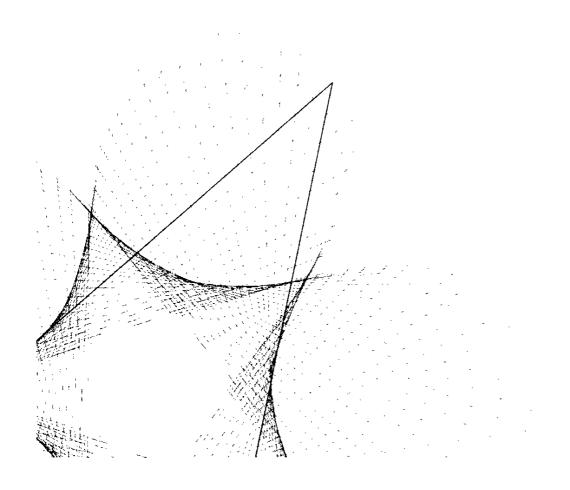

This report provides a summary of the outcome of the liquidation of the Company which has now been completed.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 The only asset outstanding at the time of my last report was the intercompany debt of £1. This has now been distributed in specie to the shareholder. There will be no further realisations.
- During the liquidation I have received a tax refund of £781.27, a book debt repayment of £150, other refunds totalling £2,720.83 and gross bank interest of £14.55.
- At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the period ended 30 January 2020 including a cumulative Receipts and Payments Account for period from 9 November 2016, being the date of my appointment, to 30 January 2020 with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values, which provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidator during the period of this report.
